## Frequently Ask Questions

### When should I arrive for class?

At least 5 minutes before your scheduled start time. Sometimes parking can be tricky so allow plenty of time to find a park and get ready. Remember to always bring a dance bag with a water bottle, notebook and pen (sticker book only for Pre School) and correct dancing shoes.

### Where do I park?

Please park in the car park spaces provided and keep the area around the main door clear. Parking can be tricky at times so older students can be dropped off at the main front door. We have a great relationship with our neighbours and share the carparks, Please drive slowly as some children sometimes weave between cars.

### Collect of Children under 7 years

We ask that students aged 7 years or younger are collected from reception and do not walk to your car. Our carpark is shared with other businesses and can become dangerous for drivers to see younger students weaving between parked cars.

### How long are Pre School Classes?

Classes are 35 minutes in duration with a 10 minute break between classes to reset the class and to speak with your teacher. Parents must wait in the reception area for the duration of the class.

### Do we need to take an exam?

All students (except Pre School) are working towards an exam/class award during Terms 1-3. There is an extra seminar for each genre to assist with preparation. Though not compulsory for graded level students it is highly recommended to help build confidence and independance. Students can also work towards awards such as Top of Grade etc. There are different dates for these depending on the genre so please check to make sure you know the dates and can keep them free.

### When is the concert?

We encourage all students to participate in a concert. Dance is a performing art and this is an important part of our program. Our concerts are held Term 4. Registrations close for the show by the end of Term 3. Details and how to register are sent out in Term 3. and can be found on our website. Concert is an additional fee to your term fees. It covers, rehearsal and costume costs.


- ❖ Focus on Technique Junior = Grades 1-5
